One item this grant will investigate is whether onion thrips spread foliar diseases. Dr. Zsofia Szendrei and Dr. Ben Werling will be playing contributing roles in this project. This may lead us to taking a deep dive into available vegetable crop insurance options during a workshop at the 2024 Expo.
